Well, that's it. The acclaimed Vertigo series comes to an end with this volume, and now it's time for the final assessment. The final serves up a final confrontation with both of the series major villains. The first is with the employer of Toyota, and is done very well. The second, unfortunately, ended rather anticlimactically. A last second motive change really took the bite out of that arc.
