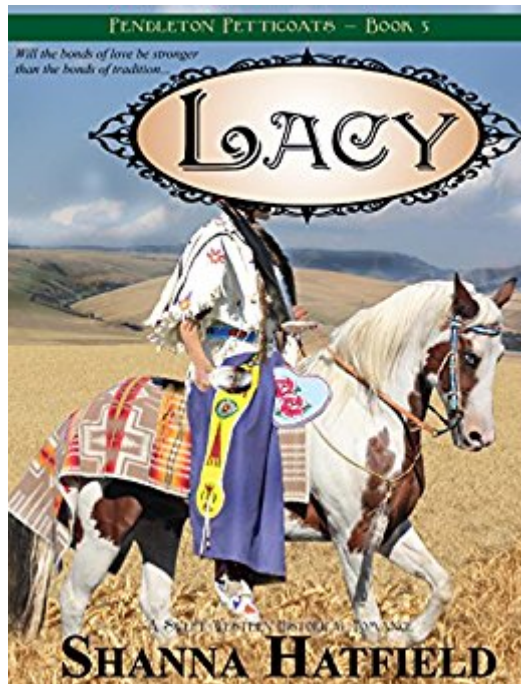


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Lacy: (Sweet Historical Western Romance) (Pendleton Petticoats Book 5)

Pendleton Petticoats Series Set in the western town of Pendleton, Oregon, this series highlights courageous women and the men who love them. The series begins in 1899, as Pendleton heads into a new century and an era as a booming, bustling city. During the early 1900s, Pendleton was considered a modern, progressive town, despite a wild west reputation. In addition to 18 bordellos and 32 saloons, Pendleton offered residents such cultured experiences as an opera house, a French restaurant, and a tea room. It was the second city in Oregon to have paved streets and boasted a telephone office as well as wonders like indoor plumbing to those who could afford the services. Servicing a huge region in Eastern Oregon, it was an entertainment hub, shipping center, and so much more, especially with the millions of bushels of wheat and pounds of wool produced in the area. While the town didn't lack for colorful characters, those portrayed in the *Pendleton Petticoats* series are purely fictional. Coming from a variety of backgrounds, the series showcases women from all walks of life who find their courage and persevere in chasing their dreams. The series, in order, includes:

Aundy (Book 1) - One stubborn mail-order bride finds the courage to carry on when she's widowed before ever truly becoming a wife, but opening her heart to love again may be more than she can bear.

Caterina (Book 2) - Running from a man intent on marrying her, Caterina starts a new life in Pendleton, completely unprepared for the passionate feelings stirred by the town's deputy sheriff.

Ilsa (Book 3) - Relying on others to guide and protect her, Ilsa finally finds the strength and courage to take control of her life. Unfortunately, her independence drives a wedge between her and the man she's come to love.

Marnie (Book 4) - Giving up on her dreams for a future, Marnie finds her hope rekindled by one caring, compassionate man and the orphans who need her.

Lacy (Book 5) - Bound by the past, Lacy dreams of a future full of excitement, adventure, and the love of a good man.

Bertie (Book 6) - Riley Walsh only wanted to

Poor Lacy Williams! Never has a deserving heroine been saddled with such adversity as this lovely Native American maiden. Lacy longs to escape from her reservation near turn-of-the-century Pendleton Oregon and make her own way in the world. Ever since the untimely death of her mother, her father has stubbornly kept to the old traditions and refuses to embrace the "white man's ways." He has already arranged a marriage for Lacy to Phillip, another man who is so hide-bound that he still lives in a tipi! Lacy escapes to Pendleton and gets a job as a telephone operator. She literally runs into the most eligible bachelor in town, Grant Hill, who owns the most successful bank in town. Grant has his own dilemma in that every single woman in town wants to marry him but seemingly only for his money and lofty status. That goes for his haughty, prideful and snobbish east-coast Mother who insists he marry a proper lady of class. Hard-working Lacy and Grant cautiously form an affectionate friendship as Grant tries to assist her but Lacy's pride and refusal to be considered a charity case get in the way. We meet all of the loveable characters from the author's previous 4 installments in the Pendleton Petticoats series (Aundy, Ilsa, Caterina, and Marnie)as they befriend the lovely and noble Lacy. One of the characters skulking around town is not so nice and becomes a dangerous threat to Lacy's security and well-being in spite of the efforts of Sheriff Kade and Lars who look after her. With threats from her father to force her back on the reservation and Grant's visiting mother who sees Lacy as just another primitive indian and a stalker who wants to bespoil her, what's a young woman to do? You'll have to read Lacy for yourself and be totally entertained

from cover to cover with this latest sweet wholesome western romance.
