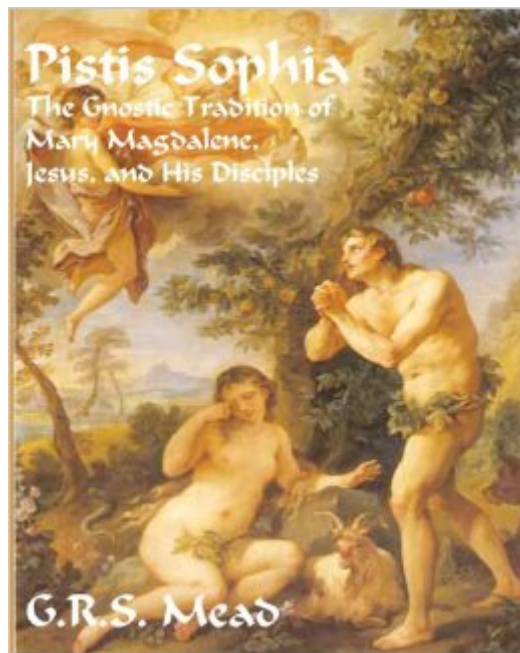


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Pistis Sophia: The Gnostic Tradition Of Mary Magdalene, Jesus, And His Disciples
